Objectives:

Publication is an important indicator of performance for individual as well as for the institution. The policy intends to encourage teachers and others for quality publications.

Scope:

Publication is one of the important criteria of measuring quality of research. Number of publications indicates the productivity of the institution in terms of quantum of research output. Number of papers published by the institution as a whole and the number of articles published per faculty member are the quantitative assessment parameters.

The teachers and the research students are not only encouraged to publish research papers but also are encouraged to write books and publish. Number of books published per faculty is a parameter for assessment.

The teachers are advised to concentrate on publication in their own interest for building their credibility. The teachers' credibility adds up, bring good reputation and credibility of the institution too. When the institute grows, the faculty members also will grow. Number of publications with research findings in peer reviewed National or International Journals, Number of research papers published in International referred journals, citation index or impact factors, and number of books published by the faculty are the quality assessment parameters.

The research policy and intellectual property right policies are separately issued. The teachers are advised to refer these policies.



Publication Guideline:

- Scientific Articles / Research Papers: Peer review is the most widely used method to judge the quality of research. The number of publications: the number of articles published by the institution as a whole and the number of articles per faculty member are important parameters.
 - The researchers / teachers are encouraged to publish in peer reviewed and high impact journals which are listed in UGC List, Scopus and Web of Science.
- Responsibility: When the students' project work / the students' work is meant for publication, they should be the first author(s). The guide or concerned teacher can be the second author. The concerned teacher is responsible for originality of work and plagiarism is within the acceptable limit.
- General Articles / Books: The teachers are encouraged to contribute general articles to newspapers, science magazines, general magazines etc. The teachers are also encouraged to write books as a part of their literary talents. The author(s) are/is responsible for the contents and the college is not responsible. The books should be published with reputed publishers and ISBN Number.
- Others like publishing newsletter / college magazine: The college forms a committee / editorial board to supervise the publication.

Support and Incentives:

The college supports the author(s) either partially or fully as publication grant to publish their work in good and prestigious journal. The research committee's recommendation is necessary.


The publications are part of appraisal system for teachers.


Publication Ethics:
